! We use the PRESENT PERFECT to talk about our *experiences in life: EX: I have tried bungee jumping *to talk about actions that have a present result: EX: Somebody has stolen my scooter, it has disappeared *To talk about actions starting in the past and going on in the present

EX:He has always loved swimming.

*Do not use past time expressions with this tense as we are interested
